

# Saint Albert 2020

## Winter Activities Guidance

### General Spectator Information:

- Saint Albert will allow 2 spectators per roster participant as per Governor's Proclamation on November 11<sup>th</sup>. The Governor's Proclamation also states that separate games are separate gatherings. So where there are two separate games, during each game, there may only be two spectators for each athlete participating in that game. Spectators would need to leave, or wait to arrive, as applicable, unless they are one of the two spectators for an athlete in the other game.
- The Governor's Proclamation does permit Pep Bands, Cheerleaders, Dance Team, and National Anthem Singers to perform at the event, but states that because they are not athletes participating in the sporting event, they do not get two additional spectators.
- There will not be a student section.
- Fans are to sit at least 6 feet away from people outside of their family and to sit every other row to help with social distancing.
- Face coverings are required at all times for all fans over the age of 2 years old at all times (entering the facility, sitting in the bleachers, and when moving around).
- All children in grades K-8 will be required to sit with their parents. Children not accompanied by an adult will not be allowed to attend activities.
- Seating could be modified depending on the event and venue. **The first two rows of bleachers will not be available for spectators on the home side and the first 3 rows of bleachers will not be available on the visiting side.**
- Frequent reminders will be made via the public address announcer
- Spectators are responsible for their own health screenings. If you are not feeling well, stay home.
- Accept personal responsibility for following public health guidelines.
- All in attendance should be watching the games, no social gathering or play will be allowed at school facilities.
- **At the completion of the athletic event, all fans must leave the facility. Parents and fans will not be allowed to wait in the gym or commons for their athletes. We ask you to wait for your child outside the building or in the parking lot.**

### Admissions:

- Event entrances may be modified depending on the event and venue.
- Admission at Varsity events will \$5 for adults and \$5 for students.
- Activity pass purchases are highly encouraged to reduce cash transactions
  - **If cash is used, the exact amount is highly recommended.**
- Admission workers will be required to wear a face-covering.
- Social distancing will be strongly encouraged in line.

### Concessions:

- **Concessions will not be available.**

### Media/Event Workers:

- All event staff and workers should remain socially distant, when possible.
- Face coverings are required for all event staff.
- Media must maintain 6 feet of distance when interviewing coaches and students.

### Important Things to Remember

- Wear a Face Covering
- Frequent Hand Washing
- Monitor Your Health - If you feel sick, stay home!
- Remain Socially Distanced (6 feet)
